A Guide to Funeral Programs

What is a Funeral Program?

A Funeral Program can be referred to as a Funeral Brochure, Pamphlet or Obituary. In all cases it is the printed document that is given out during the Funeral/Memorial Services that outlines the key points from Summarizes the Life Achievements of your deceased loved one, Order of Service and acknowledgements.

The Layout

The Funeral Program usually consists of four main sections; First the Front Cover/Main Tribute page, Following after that the Order of Service, Then the Written Obituary, and Lastly the Back Cover.

Cover / Main Tribute

The Front Cover, also known as the Main Tribute, is the first section on the Funeral Program therefor it contains the Basics and Most Important Information regarding the deceased. Information such as the full legal name as well as nicknames of the deceased, Date of Birth and Death, Date/Time and location of funeral service. The front cover will also be personalized with a photo of the deceased and can include a famous saying/biblical verse.

Written Obituary

An Obituary is where the deceased life is highlighted in a biography providing important information about the deceased; the date of birth, place of birth, parents name, education, church history, work history, achievement/accomplishments, interests/hobbies, associations of organizations, military ranking and credentials. It will also include their closest relationships (spouse, children, immediate family, lifetime friends).

Empowered Widow recommend prior to sending information over that you verify content with pastor, family members, friends, and colleagues.

Order of Service

The Order of Service follows after the written obituary, this page contains important information about how the service will flow from beginning to end. This portion may vary based on different customs of religions, cultures and usually according to the deceased's' final wishes. When completing this page, we recommend contacting the Officiating Minister/Eulogist/Pastor, Church Secretary or the funeral home. A typical Order of Service will include: Processional, Opening Prayer, Scripture Reading, Musical Selections, Acknowledgments Cards & Condolences, Remarks, Poem, Special Tribute, Praise Dancers, DVD Photo Montage, Obituary, Eulogy, Parting View and Recessional.

Back Cover

The Back Cover is the final section which includes Active and Honorary Pallbearers, Acknowledgments, Tribute Poem, Funeral Home, Interment (Burial) and Repast. This portion is a recognition and thank you to those whom have contributed to the service.

Please Note that the funeral program should capture/reflect the impacting life moments and memories of the deceased. It is a special tribute/keepsake that is usually passed on from generation to generation in honor and in memory of the deceased.
